The name in Spanish is Facultad de Educación Inicial San Andrés (the initials spelling **FEISA**). The nearest equivalent in English is St Andrew's Early Years Teacher Training College. FEISA is owned by the Anglican Church of Paraguay. Director Lourdes Calderini **gives thanks** for the **new offices** and **classrooms** and for the **permission** from the **education authorities** to **open a new course**. She **asks us to pray** for the **reorganization** of the **staff** after the recent **cost cutting measures**. Let's **pray in faith** for **40** students for the **first year** of the **degree course** and for students to **sign up** for the **Diplomas**.
